

# **Construction Update** January 2021

Argent Related, in partnership with Barnet Council, are creating a New Park Town for Future London. This is the first construction update since we launched our vision for Brent Cross Town (BXT) in October 2020. In this update, we aim to keep you informed on the completed, ongoing and upcoming construction activities and let you know how you can get in touch with us. We always welcome feedback.

#### **Main Contractors Involved**

Galldris Group: a Civil Engineering Contractor, based in Enfield with over 20 years' experience, successfully delivering multiple services to construction. Their responsibility is groundworks and major services infrastructure.

Red Construction: a Farringdon based main contractor that have successfully delivered projects in the London and the South East within the £5m to £30m range. They will be delivering our temporary Visitor Pavilion.

#### **Considerate Constructors**

- Protect the environment


At their latest review in November 2020, Galldris scored as Excellent or Exceptional across all categories.

# **Construction activities**

#### **1** Main Site

#### COMPLETED:

 U-shaped deep drainage network installed in preparation of the shared basement walls of plots 12 & 13

#### ONGOING:

- Re-levelling of ground to form BXT's new landscape
- Installation of main infrastructure (including Potable water, Electric, gas, communication and District Heating network)
- · Further excavation and re-levelling
- · Installation of basement perimeter wall

#### 2 Exploratory Park

#### COMPLETED:

- Now open from 7 am until dusk which in December & January is 4.30 pm
- It will be open Christmas and Boxing Day
- The park's manager will be on hand during opening hours to ensure the safety of everyone using the park





#### **3** Visitor Pavilion

#### COMPLETED:

- · Site hoarding extended
- · New temporary footpath created
- · Red Construction now on site

#### ONGOING:

• Groundwork & piling foundations

#### UPCOMING IN JANUARY:

• Continued building of substructure foundation

# **4** Claremont Way Retail Units

#### COMPLETED:

· Outhouses to rear completed

#### UPCOMING IN JANUARY:

 Fit-out of retail units 9 – 11 for temporary use by Red Construction

#### **5** Claremont Way Roadworks

#### UPCOMING IN JANUARY:

 Fencing off and the start of 4 months of resurfacing and utility works to create BXT's first road section. Access to the Exploratory will be maintained at all time

### 6 Claremont Open Space works

#### **UPCOMING IN JANUARY:**

 Vegetation clearance prior to nesting season in Feb 2021

# **7** Deconstruction Works

#### UPCOMING IN JANUARY:

 Deconstruction of the units that were formerly occupied by Edenway, Bstart Trading, Barkers and 115-117 Brent Terrace which will last for approximately 5 months

# 8 Construction Traffic & Pedestrian Routes

Construction vehicles will access the site from the North Circular Road via Brent Terrace (North) with access from the former industrial estate into the site taking place behind hoardings

April 2022	Claremont Park opens
December 2022	Brent Terrace West – Eastern Entrance opens
