Brent Cross Cricklewood Transformation Update



The final consultation round for the Clitterhouse Playing Fields at Brent Cross Town is now open.

Clitterhouse Playing Fields is the largest green space in Brent Cross Town that will offer local people new opportunities to take part in sport and play. Following two public consultations, one ran in October 2021 and another in March 2022, we invite the local community to share their thoughts and feedback on the proposed designs of the playing fields one last time.

Since the first consultation, over 500 people have either attended one of the in-person events, webinars, or completed a feedback form online, providing invaluable feedback. The latest designs take into account community feedback from previous consultations such as safety, accessibility, biodiversity and more.

Community Fund 2022 projects announced
