Another year of major milestones across the Brent Cross Cricklewood regeneration programme

It's been another busy year for the teams working on the Brent Cross Cricklewood programme. Across the project, we've opened a new park, supported four local businesses to open new premises and funded 11 community projects via the Brent Cross Town community fund.

We've also continued to recruit local people into jobs on our construction sites and provide skills and training opportunities. A future partnership with Sheffield Hallam University, announced in the Autumn, will also see a higher education offer developed to meet the needs of our young people that live in the area.
