Designs for a new office building at Brent Cross Town revealed, have your say

This month we shared the <u>design plans</u> for a new office building (referred to as Plot 19) at Brent Cross Town which will be based in the Station Quarter next to Brent Cross West station. The design for Plot 19 will create a unique and sustainable place for office workers, as well as provide retail space to be enjoyed by those who live close by, work in or visit Brent Cross Town.

This new milestone will bring hundreds of new construction jobs to the area and once completed, Plot 19 is anticipated to support around 850 operational jobs.

A public consultation will run from Monday 20 February to Sunday 5 March 2023. As well as

Congratulations Whitefield School



Experimental Controlled Parking Zone in some roads in the area



As part of the Brent Cross Cricklewood regeneration programme, Barnet Council is due to introduce an area wide Controlled Parking Zone.

Due to increased parking issues on some roads and to prevent non-resident parking in the area, the Council is introducing a short-term Experimental Controlled Parking Zone as an interim parking control measure. Roads covered in the Experimental Controlled Parking Zone are: Brent Terrace, Clitterhouse Crescent, Clitterhouse Road and a section of Claremont Road. Other nearby roads will also be covered in the area wide Controlled Parking Zone.
