Celebrating the fifth anniversary of Brent Cross Town Community Fund 2023

For the fifth year running, Brent Cross Town has announced that this year's Community Fund has been raised to £50k to support local initiatives and charities.

The Fund is looking to increase its reach across the community this year, with a focus on supporting groups that offer activities that provide climate education, promote a carbon net zero community; support improved local health and wellness; and promote an inclusive and socially connected community.

Local organisations and initiatives based in and around Cricklewood, Childs Hill, Golders Green, and West Hendon can apply now for grants of anywhere between £500 and £5,000. Applications to the fund close on Monday 19 June 2023.
