Brent Cross Cricklewood Transformation Update



Barnet Council has today released a 'first look' video of the new 7,000 square metre, four platform station, Brent Cross West, which is expected to open later this year.

The impressive 16-metre-high building includes a pedestrian and cycle overbridge that will connect the areas of Barnet and Brent via the Midland Main Line for the first time in 150 years.

The new video gives an aerial view of the huge new Brent Cross West station which, when it opens, will be the first major new mainline station in London in over a decade. The station will sit between Cricklewood and Hendon stations on the Midland Main Line. Thameslink trains will connect central London to Brent Cross in as little as 12 minutes, with up to eight trains an hour at peak times.


