Have you tried the new 189 bus route? Since 17 February, the 189 bus now stops outside the eastern entrance of [Brent Cross West](#) station, and continues on to Brent Cross shopping centre.

The bus drives into the new Parkview Avenue (previously called Claremont Park Road) and Arbour Street, before turning back, following the same roads to re-join Claremont Road.

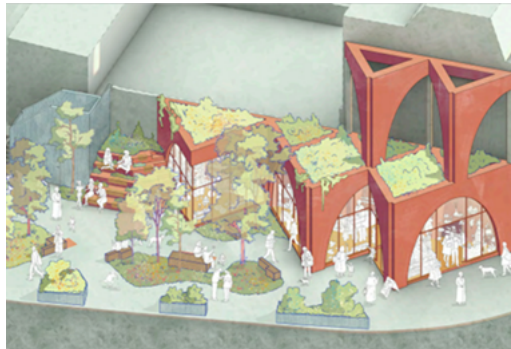
We want your feedback on Plot 22

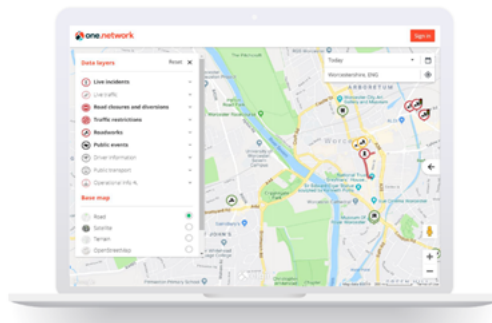
