Join Barnet's age-friendly workshop

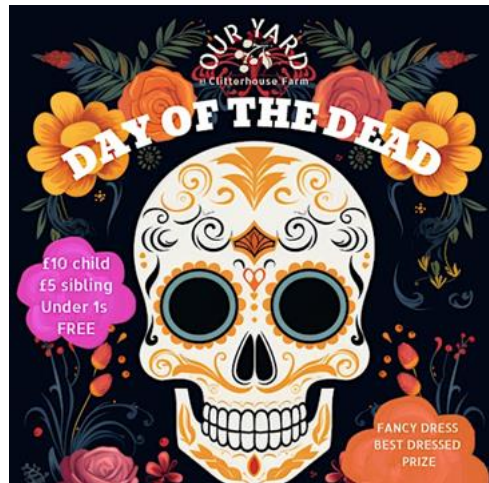
