Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to your latest update from the McLaughlin & Harvey team, working on behalf of Barnet Council on the Geron Way Waste Transfer Station.

Site operating hours

Permitted work hours will be:

Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm

Saturdays between 8am and 1pm

Concrete pours are due in April and May and whilst we will do everything possible to finish work by 6pm every evening, there is a chance that works may overrun. If they do, we will mitigate disruption as far as possible. Our project teams will be available to answer any questions via the contact details below.

Progress to date

Works are progressing well on site. From our last update we have:

- Continued construction of the concrete retaining walls adjacent to both Edgware Road and the railway
- Internal concrete walls have been constructed in the western transfer hall and installed temporary works ready for the mezzanine floor
- Continued installation of the site drainage system

Over the coming month:

- Concrete pours for the mezzanine floor in the western transfer hall
- Connection of the Thames Water stormwater diversion
- Commence construction on the eastern transfer hall
- Complete construction of retaining walls adjacent to Edgware Road and the railway

Community engagement

We continue to work and engage with the local community where possible for the duration of our work in the area.

Mathith, a Barnet resident, (pictured below with our Graduate Site Manager Sharjeel) completed his three-week work placement. This gives individuals an opportunity to get first hand experience of what life is like on a site and the different roles available.


