Clitterhouse Playing Fields update



Work is about to begin on the first phase of improvements to Clitterhouse Playing Fields, creating enhanced new spaces for sport, play and relaxation. The first phase will deliver a new multi-purpose lawn and natural amphitheatre, picnic and play areas, accessible paths and lighting. Sports facilities such as a multi-use netball/tennis court and outdoor gym zones will also be installed, plus 350 new trees and nine acres of wildflowers planted across the fields. Construction is being carefully phased to minimise disruption, with clear access routes provided throughout.
