Dear Neighbours,

Welcome to your latest update from the McLaughlin & Harvey team, working on behalf of Barnet Council on the Geron Way Waste Transfer Station.

Site operating hours

Permitted work hours will be:

Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm

Saturdays between 8am and 1pm

Concrete pours are due to take place between June and August and whilst we will do everything possible to finish work by 6pm every evening, there is a chance that works may overrun. If they do, we will mitigate disruption as far as possible. Our project teams will be available to answer any questions via the contact details below.

Progress to date

Works are progressing well on site. Since our last update:

- In the western tipping hall, all concrete pours have been completed
- In the eastern tipping hall, the concrete ground slab is now complete, with construction starting on the concrete walls and mezzanine floor
- The retaining walls along the east, south, and west perimeters are now complete
- The Thames Water stormwater diversion works are complete

Over the coming months, works will include:

- The completion of concrete pours in the eastern tipping hall
- Starting concrete pours in the central tipping hall
- The completion of the north perimeter retaining wall
- Installation of steelwork for the external cladding

Community engagement

We will continue to work and engage with the local community for the duration of our work in the area.

We've been collaborating with Middlesex University final year degree students on a project which gives them valuable experience working with a real client. The project tasked students with creating a business case on how we can sustainably support the community.

As part of our ongoing support for Middlesex University, we will also be working with students to repurpose excess pallets from site into usable items.



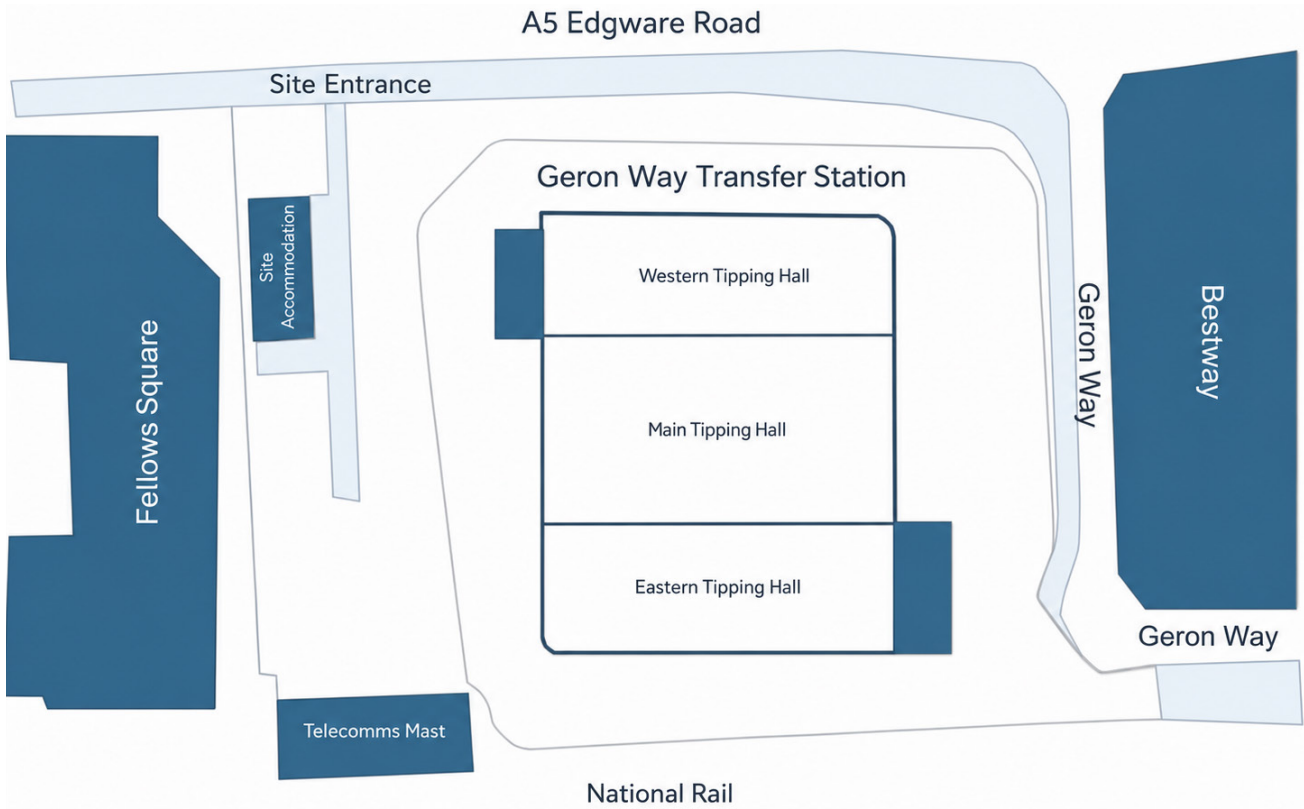
